Romans 12:1

- We were created to worship
- Nothing gives us greater satisfaction and joy
- We may feel at this time that we are not allowed to worship
- Maybe we need a new way to worship
- We want worship to give us a feeling
 - o sacrifice gives us more
 - o sacrifice results in assurance

Galatians 6:17
